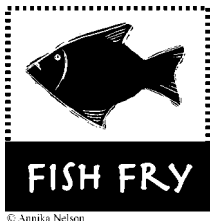

A TESTIMONY ON DIVINE MERCY

On March 22 at 7:30 pm Stanley Villavicencio will be our guest speaker. In 1993 Stanley's mother-in-law found him bleeding profusely from the mouth. After much loss of blood Stanley went into a deep coma and soon after was declared clinically dead. He woke up three days later in perfect health. As he died, the first image Stanley saw was the image of Christ as Divine Mercy. Stanley reviewed his life three times, as Jesus watched. Stanley will give his testimony and answer any questions. Veneration of the Divine Mercy image will take place at the end of Stanley's presentation. Many healings have occurred during veneration.

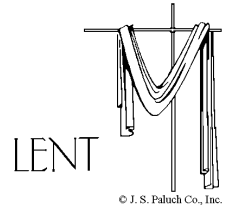

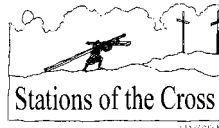
